1.	Victoria Motors Limited	<p><b>Evaluation stage at which the bid was eliminated:</b> Detailed Examination stage</p> <p><b>Reason for elimination:</b> The bidder offered a truck with an engine capacity of 5,132 cc instead of one not exceeding 4,500 cc as required. This is a material deviation, as a high fuel-consuming engine will increase the total cost of ownership in the long-run.</p>

2.	MAC East Africa Limited	<b>Evaluation stage at which the bid was eliminated:</b> Detailed Examination stage  <b>Reason for elimination:</b> The bidder offered a truck with a knuckle boom crane instead of a straight boom crane, as required. This is a material deviation, as for the purpose for which the crane is required, a knuckle boom crane has many articulating arms and seals, which will result in high maintenance costs, increased downtime, and reduced availability due to downtime.
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Display of this Notice does not constitute an acceptance of the bid described above or the formation of a contract.

Kampala Capital City Authority shall not sign a contract during a period of ten (10) days from the date of the notice. Formation of the contract shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's Rules and Procedures for Procurement of Goods and Works (May 2008 Edition, Revised July 2012).
