- 1. The **Republic of Uganda** received financing from the **African Development Bank Group** hereinafter called the "Bank" toward the cost of the **Kampala City Roads Rehabilitation Project (KCRRP)**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward eligible payments under the contracts for the "Supply and Maintenance of Road and Street Lighting Maintenance Equipment".
- 2. Kampala Capital City Authority now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the "Supply and maintenance of five (5) Skid Steer Loaders (Lot 9).

Notably, the equipment shall be delivered at the KCCA Mechanical Yard, located at 6th Street, Industrial Area, Kampala, Uganda, within 4 - 5 months of Contract signing. Margin of Preference shall not apply.

- Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (International), (OCBI) method as specified in the Bank's Procurement Framework for Bank Funded Operations approved October 2015 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework. Bidders are free to bid for one or more lots.
- 4. This tender is restricted to the member countries of the African Development Bank. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding document at the KCCA website: <u>https://www.kcca.go.ug/tenders</u>;
- 5. The bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders <u>upon the submission of a soft copy/hard copy of an officially written</u> <u>application</u> to the email address below, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Uganda Shillings 500,000/= or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency. The method of payment will be <u>online</u>, through the KCCA e-Citie online payment system, which can be accessed from the KCCA website, <u>https://ecitie2.kcca.go.ug/portal/</u>; Payment instructions are also available at: <u>https://www.kcca.go.ug/tenders</u>; Evidence of payment shall be included in the application email. No cash will be accepted. The soft copy of the bidding document will be sent by email, to the applicant's provided email address.
- 6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 11:00 Hours (local time) on Friday 27th October, 2023. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the KCCA Lower Compound at 11:15 Hours local time on Friday 27th October, 2023.
- 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of UGX. 31,000,000 or USD \$ 8,000.00.
- 8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Framework requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
